January 27th HONOLULU HOLO HOLO:

Honolulu, Oahu

May we show you around our hometown? We have much to share. Iolani

Palace, the pride of the Hawaiian Monarchy and tearful site of its 1893

overthrow. The gold sheathed statue of King Kamehameha, the great man who

first united the islands. The Punchbowl National Cemetery, USS Arizona Memorial are some of the

most important of Honolulu's historic places, they are assured to give you goose bumps or, as we

locals say, chicken-skin!

January 29th HALEAKALA UP TO THE SUN:

Kahului/Lahaina, Maui

Up you go from the sugar-caned plain, through Paniolo (Hawaiian

cowboy) country, up beyond the protea farms of Kula – "Up Country Maui" – then

above the tree line to where cacti and rare Hawaiian silverswords grow to the

very crest of Haleakala. This volcano is Maui's "House of the Sun", her

moonlike crater is the size of Manhattan, and the vistas, the islands of paradise, a view to behold!

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January 31th FRESH HOT LAVA AND COOL WATERS:

Hilo, Hawaii

In addition to the Volcanoes National Park, explore more of Hilo's surroundings, including Akatsuka Orchid Nursery and Rainbow Falls - a tropical rainforest wonder. Plus, visit Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Factory and all the natural glory of the volcanoes National Park Tour (Jackets recommended).

February 1st HISTORIC KONA:

Kona, Hawaii

We will share Kailua-Kona's history to set the stage for your trip back in time to Puuhonua O Honaunau National Historical Park – an ancient Hawaiian village of refuge for kapu (law) breakers. We'll show you a beautiful scenic view overlooking Kealakekua Bay – an underwater preserve and where a monument to Captain Cook stands. Here, he sailed in and was received as the god, Lono, however, he proved to be a mere mortal and was slain. Visit the Painted Church – the tiny church Belgian priests painted to be a grand cathedral. Experience history as rich as the brew at the Kona coffee factory which we'll visit as well!

February 02st WAIMEA CANYON TOPPER:

Nawiliwili, Kauai

Ride with us up the mountain to the 3,400 foot level and overlook

Waimea Canyon, "the Grand Canyon of the Pacific." We promise a visual history along the way – Old Koloa Town, circa 1834, heart of Hawaii's first sugar cane plantation, and Waimea, the little town that grew up where Captain Cook first set foot in Hawaii in 1778. Take a few steps along this memorable Kaua'i tour.
